SENIOR BEHAVIORAL HEALTHCARE



During our lives we will encounter changes that may be difficult to face and accept. At times these changes can be overwhelming and even debilitating.

Increased knowledge and compassion concerning mental and physical changes can help individuals begin to accept and plan for such changes.

WELCOME

At Restorations, Chambers Memorial Hospital's Senior Behavioral Health Unit, we are a new program for older adults ages 60 and above who may be clinically experiencing mental, emotional or possible behavioral health problems.

Problems to treat may include:

- Dementia which could lead to physical aggression, behavioral disturbances
- Depression with tearfulness, poor appetite, along with altered sleeping patterns- insomnia

- Anxiety with increased nervousness, worry
- Delusions or hallucinations, false beliefs in self, others, environment
- Refusal to take medications.

INTERDISCIPLINARY TEAM APPROACH

The first priority of our professional team is to perform a thorough evaluation to help determine the possible causes of the behavioral and mental changes.

Our interdisciplinary treatment team consists of the Geriatric Psychiatrist, General Physician, Advanced Practice Nurses, 24-hour nursing staff, social work and activity therapist.

Our program is designed to treat the individual holistically by meeting the behavioral, physical, spiritual, emotional and social needs.



ADMISSIONS PROCESS

Patients are commonly referred to this senior care focused program from families, nursing homes, senior housing such as assisted living, physician offices and hospitals, including emergency rooms.



A member of our staff will review information provided by families or other health care professionals to determine if your loved one, patient or resident can benefit from our program.
